Evening Post 06 Dec 1918 Death

On the 5th December, 1918, at her residence, Lower Hutt, Emma Jane Leal De Simas (Silva); aged 85 years. R.I.P. Private interment. No flowers. Mrs E. J. de Simas (Silva) died yesterday at Lower Hutt, at the age of 85. She was a very old resident of the district, where she lived since her arrival in Wellington by the ship 'Duke of Roxburgh' in 1840. She leaves three sons and three daughters.

Evening Post 22 Jul 1929 Death

On the 21st July, 1929, at Lower Hutt, Esther Anna, dearly beloved wife of J. Silva de Simas, Heke street, Lower Hutt; aged 56 years. At rest.

Evening Post 08 Sep 1932 Death

On 8th September, 1932 (suddenly), at this residence, King's crescent, Lower Hutt, Joseph Silva de Simas; aged 65 years.

Evening Post 09 Sep 1932 Obituary

Mr Joseph Silva de Simas, generally known as Mr Joseph Silva, died suddenly at his residence, King's crescent, Lower Hutt, yesterday. Mr Silva was in his usual good health on Wednesday, but when a member of his family entered his room at 8 a.m. yesterday, it was discovered that he had died in his sleep. Mr Silva's mother was one of the early settlers of Lower Hutt, having arrived in the 'Duke of Roxburgh' as a child. Mr Silva was born 65 years ago quite close to his late residence, and he resided in or about the Hutt Valley all his life. In his younger days he was a contractor for farming work, and in later years he had been engaged in farming and market gardening. Mr Silva's chief hobby was collecting native flora, on which he was an authority. Before his marriage he was an enthusiastic Volunteer, belonging to the Mounted Rifles. Mr Silva's wife predeceased him three years ago. There are five sons and two daughters. After a brief service in the home the funeral will leave for the Taita Cemetery at 2 p.m. tomorrow.
