

Group feature

The group feature is relevant to companies or groups looking to encrypt content to various public keys of the group members while using a single email address as recipient.

To use the group feature:

1. close all gpg applications and Mail.app
2. open finder, press \uparrow ⌘G
3. paste '~/gnupg/gpg.conf' without the ' and press Enter
4. open gpg.conf with TextEdit
5. add the following line at the end of the file and Save.

```
group staff@mywork.com = fingerprint1 fingerprint2 fingerprints
```

The attached Numbers file contains step 5 for all group email addresses. Just simply copy the text (to be found in the table with yellow headers) in the TextEdit file and Save.

It is possible that it takes a few minutes to process after you saved the TextEdit file. So a little patience is advised.
