Description:

As a Fundación Pies Descalzos intern you will provide on-site technical and/or pedagogical support to a One Laptop per Child pilot initiative. You will collaborate with teachers and local staff in developing innovative contents and activities that optimize the impact of technology in learning outcomes of students and promote the involvement of the community with the initiative. You will also provide support to the solution of technical problems that arise with the daily use of technology.

The project is implemented in three elementary schools in the cities of Barranquilla, Quibdó and Soacha in Colombia, serving vulnerable and displaced children. Interns are expected to build valuable relations with children and the community.

Requirements

To be successful in this role you should possess the following:

- Knowledge and a keen interest in international education
- A working knowledge of Spanish; fluency is not mandatory
- An understanding of Scratch and/or EToys (scratch.mit.edu)
