Nicolaus Copernicus University, Faculty of Economic Sciences and Management, Department of Econometrics and Statistics and Toruń School of Banking together with the *gretl development team*¹ invites the submission of papers for its **2nd *gretl* Conference** which will be held in Toruń, Poland (June 16-17, 2011) and hosted by The Faculty of Economic Sciences and Management of Nicolaus Copernicus University.

This conference is the second world meeting of *gretl* users and developers with invited speakers Allin Cottrell (Wake Forest University) and Riccardo “Jack” Lucchetti (Università Politecnica delle Marche).

We invite all *gretl* users to submit papers presenting innovations or exciting applications of *gretl* on topics such as:

- Teaching econometrics and statistics using free software
- Implementation in *gretl* of some econometric technique
- Methodological papers with a strong computational emphasis
- Applications using *gretl*
- Developing *gretl*

Ideally, submitted papers should be done with *gretl* but papers containing statistical and econometric applications done in any other package, could be acceptable provided that the paper or the discussion contains a section on what *gretl* lacks to do the same.
