f(a::Integer, b::Integer) = "a and b are both  
integers"
```

Out[8]: f (generic function with 5 methods)

In[9]: f(1.5,2)
```

```
Out[9]: "a and b are both numbers"
```

```
In[10]: f(1,"bar")
```

```
Out[10]: "a is a number"
```

```
In[11]: f(1,2)
```

```
Out[11]: "fallback"
```
