I found Dan Alexander Probe (and his siblings) after I searched the cemetery for Surnames. File saved as "Radville Laurier Cemetery.doc".

The first reference for this cemetery was found when I discovered an obituary while searching for Probe obituaries. Barrie Probe was mentioned in the obituary for Lorne Wallin with Bonnie listed as Barrie's wife. So, I verified her maiden name and another couple of (maybe 3 or 4) generations of Wallin's after searching the cemetery's records.

There were also 3 Probe's buried there, all children. The 2 "stillborn" children that Anne Probe spoke of at the 1990 Regina family reunion and I was able to verify the birth/death records of the daughter of Jacob and Eva Probe. Her name was Eva also. See notes on Eva for other details.
